Below are tips on how to help keep your company safe.

S

STAY RELEVANT

Keep your anti-virus software, web browser and operating system up-to-date.

PATCH IT UP

Install all security patches as soon as you are notified.

THINK BEFORE YOU CLICK

Don't click on links in emails from people you don't know. Fraudsters are hoping you will.

BACK IT UP

Data loss doesn't come with a warning. Be sure to back up all of your computing devices.

BE POSITIVE

Automate the daily review of checks using Payee Positive Pay.

TWO IS BETTER THAN ONE

Use dual control for better internal controls.

BE ACH POSITIVE

Automate the daily review of ACH debit transactions.

WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT

If an email, link or post looks suspicious, delete and/or mark as junk.

NAMES MATTER

Use **PAYEE** Positive Pay to match payee name on checks presented for payment.

LOOK BACK

Review account transaction history on a daily basis to spot fraudulent activity.

BE WIFI SAVVY

Public wireless networks and hotspots are not secure.

BE ALERT

Use system alerts to automatically notify you by text or email about account activity.
