



# Cybersecurity Awareness

Below are tips on how to help keep you safe.

## S

### STAY RELEVANT

Keep your anti-virus software, web browser and operating system up-to-date.

### PATCH IT UP

Install all security patches as soon as you are notified.

### THINK BEFORE YOU CLICK

Don't click on links in emails from people you don't know. Fraudsters are hoping you will.

### BACK IT UP

Data loss doesn't come with a warning. Be sure to back up all of your computing devices.

## A

### BE SECURE

Use strong passwords or touch ID features to lock your devices.

### KEEP IT CLEAN

Uninstall mobile apps you no longer use.

### THINK BEFORE YOU APP

Be cautious about which apps you allow to collect your personal information.

### BE UNIQUE

Use separate passwords for every account.

## F

### WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT

If an email, link or post looks suspicious, delete and/or mark as junk.

### LOOK BACK

Review account transaction history on a daily basis to spot fraudulent activity.

### BE WIFI SAVVY

Public wireless networks and hotspots are not secure.

### BE ALERT

Use system alerts to automatically notify you by text or email about account activity.
